## BOOKS.07 works of imagination

An exhibition program of artists' books  
24 August to 30 September 2007

### Conditions of entry

1. All works are required to reflect this year's theme: **The Search for the Impossible.**
2. Entry by pre-selection only. Closing date **9 July 07.**  
Requirements:
  - a) CD of relevant images in jpg or tif format at 300 dpi with the following information:  
*title, materials used, date completed, dimensions and photographer.*
  - b) CV and 50 word artist statement.
3. Successful applicants will be notified by 23 July 07.
4. Due to customs regulations, only Australian works may be for sale. Commission of 25% is applicable.
5. Entries limited to one work per artist. A non-refundable fee of \$22 (incl GST) is payable.
6. ABN or hobbyist declaration is required from Australian artists if item is for sale.
7. All expenses in connection with the transit insurance, forward packing, repacking, and return of entries is the responsibility of the artist.
8. The Gallery will take the greatest care with all exhibits, but accepts no liability for damage or loss incurred to works held after 7 October 2007.
9. All remaining books with no return postage will be sent COD.
10. The Gallery reserves the right to have any work photographically or otherwise reproduced for publicity and archival purposes.

All entries must be the original work of the artist and have been executed within the last 12 months.

- \$22 non-refundable fee (only applicable to Australian artists)

**Payment by:** Credit Card, Cheque or Money Order payable to Noosa Regional Gallery.
