



THE PRIORITIES OF GALLERY 3 ARE TO PROMOTE AND SUPPORT:

- Emerging Artists
• Regional Artist
• Installation Artists; and
• Provide professional development for Artists

All prospective exhibitors must complete an application form. A single artist or group of artists may apply.

EVALUATION PROCEDURE FOR APPLICATIONS

The evaluation procedure will be based on the applicability of the submission to the selection priorities i.e. emerging artists, regional artists, installation artists and professional development for artists. Additionally, the strength of concept (expressed in the artist statement and exhibition rationale) and technical competency will be assessed. Acknowledgment of receipt of the application will be issued within the fortnight and the application will be processed within 6 weeks.

GALLERY RESPONSIBILITIES

The Gallery will provide the following:

- Advice on professional exhibition practice
• An exhibition checklist
• Assistance with installation of the exhibition
• A separate contract for each artist/s
• Insurance during the exhibition
• Wall text and didactics where applicable
• Opening costs
• Exhibition Invitation: 700 - 1000 one-side full colour
• Drafting of media release
• Distribution of media release
• Email marketing
• Upload to Gallery website
• Mailout (including 20 personal invitations)

COSTS

The cost to the artist/s is \$660 including GST per exhibition. Once accepted, the artist will pay a \$330 non-refundable deposit. A further \$330 will be paid a month before the commencement of the exhibition. The Noosa Regional Gallery will take a 30% commission on all sales.

ARTIST RESPONSIBILITIES

The artist/s will be responsible for the transport and insurance of works to and from the Gallery. The artist/s will need to provide the works at a state ready to be installed and provide any specialised installation hardware. The artist/s will be responsible for any damage caused to works by the artist/s themselves during installation and the exhibition.

During exhibition development, the Artist will be required to supply:

- Images of all artworks with details of artwork including photography attribution
• List and price of artworks for the gallery catalogue and insurance
• Completed marketing checklist

TERMS OF ACCEPTANCE

The artist/group may apply for an exhibition up to two years from the application date. In the application the images must be of work which exemplify the artist's statement and allude to the proposed exhibition rationale. This is important, as the work for the proposed exhibition may not have been created at the time of application.

If the artist/group is accepted for an exhibition, the artist must supply images of the exhibition work four months prior to the opening. If the work does not reflect the original rationale, the gallery has the right to withdraw from the exhibition agreement. If this occurs, the deposit will be refunded.

If the artist/group significantly change their rationale after they have been accepted, they can negotiate with the Gallery Director to accept the new rationale.
